**Re:** April 10 Crash Investigation involving CGSO Deputy Now Complete

On Sunday, April 10, 2016, at approximately 6:53 p.m. Mason City Police were called to a motor vehicle crash at S Federal Avenue and 5<sup>th</sup> Street. The crash involved two vehicles, one of those was a Cerro Gordo County Sheriff's Office vehicle being driven by an on-duty deputy sheriff. Neither driver was injured in the crash.

The CGSO vehicle was being driven by Deputy Zach Scott, from Mason City, and was westbound on 5<sup>th</sup> Street on a green light. The other vehicle was driven by Miricle Corbo, of St. Ansgar, and was northbound on Federal Avenue on a red light. Scott was in the intersection when his vehicle was struck by Corbo's.

Scott's Chevrolet Tahoe had approximately \$4,000 in damage and was towed from the scene. Corbo's Chrysler Sebring suffered approximately \$5,000 in damage and was also towed. An investigation was completed at the scene and included a review of video footage from the patrol vehicle. The investigation into this crash is now complete. Corbo is being cited for failure to obey a traffic control device.
