Re: Stolen bicycles recovered

On Friday, June 3rd, the Mason City Police Department served a search warrant at a garage behind 207 6th Street N.E. Two bicycles and an iPad found during the search were stolen during a burglary in Mason City on May 12th. Additionally, several more bicycles, bike frames and other parts were discovered in the garage. Some of the bikes had been repainted and parts swapped from other bikes.

Arrested during this investigation was Jacob Raymond Shafer (25), no permanent address. Shafer was charged with possession of stolen property in the 2nd degree; a class D felony. He is currently being held at the Cerro Gordo County Jail.
