#### **Tyler**


- Steady working with families and individuals on burial and pre-need situations

- Planning ahead for Summer projects, including tree removal and replacement, continued beautification of cemetery sections



# Cemetery Plot, Columbarium, and Foundation Price Changes Proposal

I have been doing some extensive research on current plot and columbarium niche pricing in markets similar to Mason City. We have not changed our pricing on plots since 2016. With the increased inflation and significant shift in increased cremation, I would like to propose pricing adjustments to meet the increased financial demands of the cemetery:

#### **Plot Adjustments:**

- \$500 per plot (previously \$400 flat marker only): Ascension, Edgemont
- \$350 per plot (previously \$250 flat marker and urn only): Grandview Gardens
- \$200 per plot (previously \$100 flat marker only): Lullaby Land
- \$600 per plot (previously \$500 monument only): Trinity Hill
- \$550 per plot (previously \$450 flat, bevel, slant on single plot; monument allowed on two or more spaces): all other sections

#### **Columbarium Adjustments:**

\$1,495 (previously \$1,295 - single niches at Water's Edge and Reflections, the two
newest columbariums near the pond); significant increase the past few years in
engraving costs lead to the increase in pricing

### **Foundation Adjustments:**

- Pad #1-\$499 (previously \$399 36 x 22 )
- Pad #2 \$599 (previously \$499 56 x 22)
- Pad #3 \$699 (previously \$599 70 x 22)

Concrete company has added an hourly rate when they bring concrete, along with an added freight cost increase when we purchase the pre-finished concrete pads

In general, these adjustments allow us to remain more sustainable, while also offering a fair, market rate for our services. If you have any questions or concerns, please let me know. I would like to discuss this proposal during our board meeting on February 13th, 2025, at 10am, cemetery office.
